

How to make... a cat paper bag puppet

Suitable for ages 3 - 5 with adult help or
6 - 11 working independently

You will need:



- Paper bag
- Cat templates
- Felt tip pens, colouring pencils or crayons
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions

Step 1:

Decide which face template you would like to use, then cut them all out.


Step 2:

Colour in your templates. Fold the mouth piece in half along the dotted line.



Step 3:

Colour in the main body of the paper bag. Maybe you could add stripes for a tabby cat or a little white tummy. Or you could choose to make a tiger or leopard.



Step 4:

Put lots of glue on the back of the mouth and chin piece and stick it under the flap, like in the photo.



Step 5:

Put lots of glue on the top of the flap and glue the top half of the head in place.

Step 6:

Draw on any extra details you like. You could add whiskers or a tail. Glue the tail to the back of the paper bag.




Congratulations, your cat paper bag puppet is complete!

Put your hand inside the bag and tuck your fingers into the folded flap. Open and close the flap to make your new sidekick talk.




