- Thin card (a cereal box works well)



Instructions

Step 1:

Print out our templates and colour them in using whatever you like: colouing pencils, felt tip pens, crayons.



Step 2:

Stick your emperor onto some thin card.




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Step 3: Cut your emperor out.



Step 4:Cut out your clothes. Be careful not to cut off the tabs.



Step 5:Fold back all the tabs and use them to hold your clothes in place. Have a play and mix and match your outfits to make an incredible wardrobe.
