- Scissors
- Glue
- Thin card (a cereal box works well)

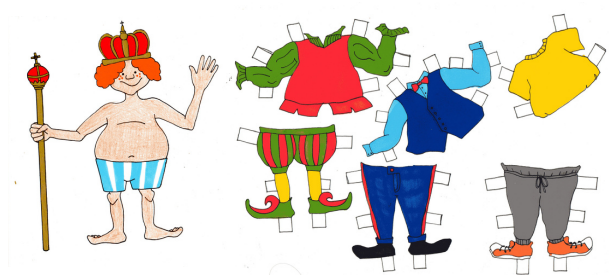

## Instructions

### Step 1:

Print out our templates and colour them in using whatever you like: colouring pencils, felt tip pens, crayons.

## Step 4:

Cut out your clothes. Be careful not to cut off the tabs.



## Step 5:

Fold back all the tabs and use them to hold your clothes in place. Have a play and mix and match your outfits to make an incredible wardrobe.
