

How to make... a Paperplate Scaryglow

Bill, the Scaryglow, is the friendliest monster in all the land! He can use his big fluffy belly to help people to see in the dark.

Here's how to make your very own Bill!







You will need:

- A torch
- A black marker pen
- Scissors
- Glue (I used a glue stick so I could draw around it for the eyes)
- A kitchen sponge
- Card- Blue, Purple, red and white
- Blue tissue paper
- A paper plate
- 2 paper cups
- A paintbrush
- Blue and purple paint (Any type of paint will do)

(Additional sticky tape can be used to help secure items)

If you have a purple sponge and blue paper plates and cups, you don't need to paint anything!



Instructions


Step 1:

Using the pen, draw the outline of The Scaryglow and his belly.

Using the picture as a guide, draw a tuft of hair at the top of the plate, a few tufts on each side and a large egg shape for the Scaryglow's belly.



Next, using a pair of scissors (or get someone to help you with this), cut out the belly and outline.



Step 2:

Using a pen, it's time to draw out the body parts needed.

On the blue card we need

- 2x arms
- 2x ears.
- 2x eyelids

On the red card

• 1x tongue


On the purple card


- 2 x eyebrows
- 2 x ears (smaller than the blue ones)

on the white card

• 2x eyeballs (I drew around the glue stick lid)

Cut out the body parts and leave to one side.






Step 3:

Take a kitchen sponge and draw a half circle for the nose.

Cut it out with the scissors.

(If your plate and cups are blue and the sponge is purple, you can skip the next step)



Step 4:

Time for some painting!

Paint the cups and plate blue.





Paint the nose purple.



Step 5:

Time to assemble the eyes and ears.

Using the picture as a guide, take an eyeball and stick the eyelid on the top half. Next, take an eyebrow and stick it on top.

Draw on the pupil with the pen.

Repeat for the 2nd eye!





For the ears-

Using the picture as a guide, take a smaller purple ear and stick it on top of the blue one.

Step 6:

Using the image on the right as a guidestick the ears, eyes and nose onto the plate.







Step 7:

Using the images on the right, draw on the mouth with the black pen and add the tongue.

Step 8:

Turn the plate over and stick the blue tissue paper over the belly hole.



Stick the 2 cups either side of the belly on the back of the plate. Make sure they hang slightly below the bottom of the plate so the Scaryglow will have feet.

If the cups won't stick then you can use some tape to help secure them.

Stick the arms on either side of the plate, about half way up.



Step 9:

Turn the plate back over and fold the arms forward over the front of the plate.





Step 7:

Now you have your very own Scaryglow called Bill!

Shine a torch behind to make his belly glow! He can now help you to see in the dark
