Ellie first joined Little Angel as the Participation Manager promoting the importance of drama and puppetry in the lives of children; helping to inspire their creativity and imagination as well as increase their confidence. Now as the In-House Designer she has worked on shows for both stage and screen including Charlie Cook's Favourite Book, Mother Christmas, Bugaboo and Reach for the Stars. Last year Ellie co-created an interactive, touring show that coupled live theatre with AR technology to create a unique theatrical experience for children and young people isolated in hospitals, bringing the magic of puppetry to their bedside. This show was then re-mounted as a digital tour this year.

Aya Nakamura is a London based theatremaker, puppeteer, puppetry director and puppet maker originally from Japan.
