DAVID DUFFY - Adaption & Direction

David has lit over 25 Little Angel productions, and has delivered talks on lighting design for puppetry at PLASA, RCCD, Showlight in Florence and the HipFest in Iceland. Recent credits include Jonny Feathers the Rock and Roll Pigeon (Riverside), Little Manfred (Soldiers Arts Academy), Paper Dolls (Polka) and Five Little Monkeys (Hurlingham Club)

ANDREA SADLER - Adaption & Performer

Andrea is an actor, singer, puppeteer, writer and director. She is delighted to be returning to Little Angel with Dogs Don't do Ballet, which she co-created. She performed at the Hvammstangi International Puppetry Festival this summer which won The Fox Award for Excellence in Puppetry Theatre. Prior to that she was working on the development of a new show, The Quilt, with Cubic Feet at National Theatre Studios. Andrea worked with Tall Stories for most of 2023 in The Smeds and the Smoos (West End, national tour and Singapore). Puppetry credits include Five Little Monkeys/ Five Little Christmas Monkeys (Baby Panda), The Dong With a Luminous Nose (Metal Rabbit/ Cubic Feet/ Monstro Theatre), Little Angel by the Sea (co-writer and performer), A Very Old Man With Enormous Wings (Kneehigh), Cindermouse, Fantastic Mr Fox, The Fabulous Flutterbys, Goldilocks, The Wild Night of the Witches (all Little Angel Theatre) and Bookstory (Monstro Theatre). Other favourite roles include A Christmas Carol (Antic Disposition); Fairy Bow-Belle in Dick Whittington opposite Blue Peter legend Peter Duncan; Round the Horne: Revisited (national tour); The Canterbury Tales (Nottingham Theatre Royal), The Basil Brush Show for CBBC. Andrea's own company Baby Panda is in the final stages of developing a show for 2025 based on the popular children's book, Heidi.

KEITH FREDRICK - Puppet Design

Keith has been designing and making puppets and their costumes, professionally, since 2008. In this time, he has worked on several shows for the Little Angel Theatre. It would be fair to say that, since the age of 5, puppetry has always been and always will be his favourite language, and one which continues to teach him something new every day. Other Credits include: Red Earth Theatre, Birmingham Stage, The Polka Theatre, Nickelodeon, Baby Cow productions, Nice Fish by Mark Rylance, RSC & LAT, LAT & Kneehigh, Nexus productions for the BCC, Middle Earth Productions USA, Daryl Worbey Studios and Oily Cart, to name a few.

Ronnie started his professional career at the Little Angel Theatre way back in the early 60s he toured with the company all over Europe and Great Britain. He is delighted to be performing in Dog's Don't Do Ballet again as he was in the two person original cast. As a freelance Puppeteer he has appeared in films made by Jim Henson and Frank Oz. His latest appearance is in A Quiet Place Day One which premiered this year. His television appearances are numerous, but he is well known for being the puppeteer of 'Zippy' in Rainbow (Thames Televisions). He teaches his puppet operating skills regularly at the Little Angel foundation courses. And for the Curious School of Puppetry.

MAKE YOUR OWN DANCING ANIMAL PUPPET!

> No matter what height or age, whether you're a dog or girraffe when your put your mind and passion into it... you can do anything!

You need:

- x2 lollypop sticks
- 1 sheet of card to make your creation (this can be coloured paper or you can colour it in your self!)
- String
- Scissors
- x4 butterfly pins



How to:

- Draw onto your sheet of card any animal you like! eg. Dog, Cat, Tiger, Mouse etc.
- Next, colour in your creation you could even draw on clothes and shoes!
- Take your scissors and cut out each part of your drawing. For example, you want to separate the legs, head, body and arms so that they're all different pieces (ask an adult to help out here)
- Place all the pieces back together now and use the butterfly pins to secure it back together on top of the body.
- Next, place the lollypop sticks on top of each other in an 'X' shape and glue in this position and glue a piece of string to all 4 ends.
- The final step is to pierce a hole into both ends of each part of your creation and tie the strings from the lollypop sticks to the ends of the arms/hands, and end of the legs/feet (make sure the left strings attach to the left side of the body and same with the right. Also tie a piece of string from the top of the head to the centre of the lollypop sticks cross.

Watch your little creation dance around as you tilt and bounce the lollypop sticks!
