SAMANTHA LANE - Director

Samantha Lane began her tenure as Director at Little Artistic Theatre in 2015. She was formerly Director of Projects at the Almeida Theatre where she made theatre for, by and with young people aged 14-25; Manager at the Education and Queen's Theatre, Hornchurch, where she created numerous Theatre-in-Education shows for primary and schools. secondaru as directing community plays with casts of 60+ people. During her time at LAT, she has commissioned programmed over 150 shows, and adapted/directed over 10 of these.

KATHERINE HAW -Directing Assistant

Katherine recently graduated with a postgraduate Masters degree in Dramaturgy from Birkbeck, London. Her research focused on how we can elevate the presence of actors with invisibility disabilities on stage through the use of dramaturgy. This is her first time assisting with directing, and her first time working with puppets!

OLIVER HYMANS - Designer

Oliver Hymans is an award-winning puppetry artist and director. He has worked internationally across four continents, directing and designing puppetry in theatre, opera, film and music video. Oliver's puppets have appeared at London's Tate Modern, Arcola Theatre, Royal Albert Hall, The National Galleru, Camden Roundhouse and The Institute of Contemporary Arts. His shows have been described as being "visually dazzling... funny and beautiful...poetic and precise" (The Guardian), with "dazzling technical flourishes" (The Stage). Design Credits include: The Instrumentals, A Christmas Carol in the Painted Hall, The Legend of the Jazz Penguin (for Goblin Theatre); Rosie Robin and the Christmas Post, Prince Charming, The Wishing Tree (Little Angel Theatre); and many more. Oliver is currently Associate Director at Little Angel Theatre and a 2021 **QEST** Scholar specialising in traditional marionette carving; in 2023 he finalist for was a of Woodworker the Year recognition of his successful work to get marionettes added to the Red List of Endangered Crafts.

ALISON ALEXANDER - Puppet Maker

Alison is a Theatre Designer-Maker specialising in puppetry and devising. Once upon a time she graduated from Wimbledon School of Art in Design for Performance and trained in puppet design with Lundie Wright at Little Angel Theatre. With a career spanning more then 50 productions, Alison has designed, made, and toured with companies including as Little Angel Theatre, Kneehigh, The Globe, Tate Modern, Goblin Theatre, Theatre Rites, LAS theatre, Nearly there Yet and Monstro Theatre. 
SHERRY COENEN -Lighting Design


ALEX BRADFORD - Stage Manager
